Agenda Item 4: Request for Crosswalk on Morgan Drive at Stadium Drive

Mr Haberman stated that they will also work with the School District engineers on their findings and make recommendations if needed. Item will be placed on the October agenda. Agenda Item 5: Request for Sign Stating "Traffic From Left Does Not Stop" on N. Meadowcroft at Intersection with Dell Avenue.

Mr. Haberman stated that over the summer, Gateway recommended to Commission the installation of two "Oncoming Traffic Does Not Stop" signs be installed at this intersection. Commission approved and the signs were installed. Mr. Haberman presented to the board conceptual pavement markings that could also be installed to improve the intersection. Board members requested that additional options be presented. These options will be presented at the October meeting. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 6: Request to Review Stop Signs at the Intersection of Serpentine Drive & Altoona Place.

Mr. Haberman stated that this intersection was reviewed in October 2014 and the stop sign was installed based on the recommendation from the board. There have been no accidents at this intersection. No one was present to discuss this item. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 7: Request to Review Signage and Sight Distance at the Intersection of Connor Road & Marshall Drive.

Mr. Haberman stated that due to the signage blocking the sight line at the intersection of Marshall Drive & Connor Road Public Works moved the sign. No further action was taken.
