Mr. Clark opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Mr. Glock, Mr. Fitzgerald, Ms. Krieger, Ms. Amin were absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from Chair

### **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Request for Crosswalk on Morgan Drive at Stadium Drive

Item was tabled until the November 1, 2017 meeting.

Agenda Item 5: Request for Sign Stating "Traffic From Left Does Not Stop" on N. Meadowcroft at intersection with Dell Avenue.

Item was table until November 1, 2017 meeting.

### **New Business:**

Agenda Item 5: Request for Speed and Crosswalk Enforcement on Bower Hill between Cochran Rd. and Washington Rd.

Maggie Thomas, 221 Bower Hill Road spoke regarding safety issues near the crosswalk on Bower Hill Road at Ralston Place. She suggested extending the school zone on Ralston from Lincoln School to Bower Hill Road; limit traffic on Ralston Place to right turns only onto Bower Hill Road; install lighted signs and pavement lights at crosswalk & prohibit left hand turns onto Marlin Drive.

Ms. Hillary Burns, 331 Bower Hill Road spoke regarding her concerns with speed and the number of accidents in this area of Bower Hill. Ms. Burns presented a petition from residents in the area requesting improvements for pedestrian safety.

No further actions was taken. Crash data will be presented at the November meeting.

Agenda Item 7: Request for Parking Restrictions on Edward Avenue.

Lt. Rayburg advised that the Commissioners were working on changes to the over-night parking ordinance. No one was present to discuss this request. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 8: Request for Parking Restriction on Inglewood Drive.

Mr. Haberman stated that he observed this area on Saturday, September 30 during peak soccer games at Bird Park. Mr. Haberman will present his recommendations at the November 1, 2017 meeting. Letters will be sent to area residents. No one was present to speak on this item.

Agenda Item 9: Request for Four Way Stop at Intersection of Morrison Drive and Newburn Drive.

Ms. Haley Nagy, 186 Morrison Drive spoke regarding the speed and visibility in this area of Morrison Drive. She stated that visibility is very poor on the bend especially when vehicles are parked on the right hand side of the road.

Ms. Laura Strauss, 175 Morrison Drive also spoke regarding the poor visibility when coming down the hill.

No action was taken. Crash and sight distance data will be presented at the November meeting.

Agenda Item 10: Request for Review of Intersections along Holly Lane and Helen Drive.

Ms. Haley Nagy, 186 Morrison Drive stated there are no stop signs at these intersections. Mr. Haberman will review and present his findings at the November meeting.

Agenda Item 11: Request for Yield Sign at Intersection of Beverly Road and Newburn Drive.

Ms. Haley Nagy, stated that there is no signage for drivers to yield when turning from Beverly Road onto Newburn Drive. Mr. Haberman will review and present his findings at the November meeting.

Agenda Item 12: Items from the Floor

Ms. Joanne Ballia spoke regarding parking restrictions on McCully Street. Ms. Ballia stated that Commissioner Bendel did not receive the board's recommendation from May 2017 regarding her request and asked that it be re-sent.
