Mr. Fitzgerald opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Mr. Glock was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from Chair

Agenda Item 3: Meeting Notes from February 7, 2018

Motion was made to approve the minutes from the February 7, 2018 meeting. Motion was approved and passed unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Request for Stop Sign at Intersection of Valleyview Road and Couch Farm Road.

Mr. Haberman stated a site visit was conducted at the intersection of Valleyview Road and Couch Farm Road to review the sight distance and existing traffic control. At the February meeting, a motion was made to recommend the installation of stop signs and was passed unanimously. Letters were sent to residents in the area inviting them to attend the March meeting to address their concerns. No one was in attendance and the motion will stand. No further action.

### **New Business:**

Agenda Item 5: Request for Stop Signs, Crosswalks and Pedestrian Stanchions at Intersection of Hoodridge Drive and Rockwood Avenue.

Commissioner McLean spoke regarding the crosswalks and signage at this intersection. He requested that additional improvements be made to the crosswalk due to the paint fading and also additional signage.

Mr. Haberman stated that in depth traffic calming studies were conducted at this intersection in 2013 and 2016 and these studies showed that traffic calming was not warranted, including stop signs. Mr. Haberman stated that he will do a further review of the intersection to improve the visibility of the crosswalk and signage. A summary report will be presented at the April meeting. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 6: Request for Hourly Parking Limit on McCully Street.

Mr. Haberman stated that a recommendation was sent to Commissioners in May 2017 to consider recommendation #7 under the Proposed Concepts and Strategies in the parking study that was completed by Environmental Planning & Design. He also stated that the parking board, will be looking into adding Saturday enforcement on Beverly Road along with the engineering work for the Overlook lot expansion.

Board members agreed that the recommendation made in May should stand. No further action was taken. No one was in attendance to address this request.

Agenda Item 7: Request for School Zone designation and signage on Lebanon Drive between Cochran Road and Towercrest Drive.

Ms. L. Csont requested that the current school zone from Cochran Road onto Lebanon Avenue be extended to Towercrest Drive. She stated the school zone currently runs just west of Cochran Road and does not include Horsman Drive. She also stated the school zone signage has not been replaced.

Board members requested that Mr. Haberman conduct a review of this area. Mr. Haberman will report his findings at the April meeting.

Agenda Item 8: Request for Pedestrian Safety at Stadium Drive and Morgan Drive.

Mr. Haberman stated that this request was brought to the board in May and a motion was made to install pavement markings at the intersection to better delineate the Stadium Drive approach to the intersection. He stated that Public Works will be installing the markings in the spring.

Ms. Csont spoke regarding additional improvements to steer students in the right direction to use the crosswalk. Board members agreed that this area is the high schools responsibility and any additional changes should be made by them. No further action was taken.
