- **Public Comment.** Residents Kathy Hrabovsky and Heather Wechter commented on glass recycling.
- **Approval of August 9, 2018 Minutes.** Martin motioned to approve the August 2018 minutes. Sarah seconded and all members in attendance approved.
- **ESB Business**
  - **Funding for storm water signage** – the Board members questioned whether funding would be available for the signage, even though grant money was not available. Bonnie reported that the municipality would provide the match for the signage if a grant is received in the next grant cycle.
  - **Discussion of ESB role in recycling education.** Bonnie asked the group if anyone would be interested in forming a subcommittee to discuss education with the municipality if needed. Nora indicated she would be available.
  - **Options for glass recycling.** Martin reported that Dlubak Glass would be happy to take the glass recycling, but would not provide pick-up services. Sarah reported that CAP Glass, one of the nation's largest glass recyclers, would agree to accept glass at its McKees Rocks facility, but could not pick up glass either.
  - Natalie reported via email on Harrisburg's glass recycling operation; the information is attached.
- **Commission Business.**
  - Bonnie advised the members that information regarding the recycling communication plan would be introduced at the August 14 meeting, and that the actual trash contract would be introduced at the August 27 meeting.
- **New Business.** Mt. Lebanon High School was recognized as a Green Ribbon school.
- **Adjournment.** Nora motioned to adjourn the meeting and was seconded by Martin, and unanimously approved by the members present.
