

MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: December 4, 2019

Mr. Sloan opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Mr. Waine and Mr. Glock were absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from Chair

Agenda Item 3: Meeting Notes from November 6, 2019.

Motion was made to approve the minutes from the November 6, 2019 meeting. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Old Business:

Agenda Item 4: Request for Parking Restrictions on Castle Shannon Blvd. At Cornell Place.

Board members made a recommendation to install parking restrictions on Castle Shannon Blvd. at Cornell Place at the November meeting. Letters were sent to residents in the area inviting them to attend the December meeting to voice their concerns. No one was in attendance. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 5: Request to Evaluate Signal Timings and Lane Configuration at the Intersection of Cedar Boulevard and Morgan Drive / Greenhurst Drive.

Mr. Brown, Gateway Engineers stated that this request was brought to the board at the October meeting and recommendations were presented at the November meeting. Mr. Brown stated that this project would require the expenditure of capital funds with Commissioners approval. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 6: Request for Pedestrian Safety Improvements on Robb Hollow at the Intersection with Sylvandell and Driftwood.

Mr. Brown, Gateway Engineers reported that the Police Department collected preliminary data during a 5 day period in November and Gateway conducted a field visit. Gateway is still evaluating the data collected and expects to present their recommendations at the January 2020 meeting. No further action was taken.

New Business:

Agenda Item 7: Request for Traffic Calming on Crystal Drive between Broadmoor and Country Club.

A request was received to table this item until January. No further action.

Agenda Item 8: Request for Traffic Study on Cedar Blvd.

No one was in attendance to address this issue. No further action.

Agenda Item 9: Request for Stop Sign and No Right Turn on N. Meadowcroft Avenue at Edward Avenue.

Mr. Carmine Bellini stated he was almost struck by a vehicle while crossing N. Meadowcroft Avenue at Edward Avenue. Mr. Bellini suggested a stop sign at the intersection would slow vehicles in this area. Board members requested Gateway conduct a study of this intersection. Findings will be presented at the January 2020 meeting.

Agenda Item 10: Request for Traffic Study on Marlin Drive East.

Mr. Frank Lupinacci, 111 Marlin Dr. East spoke regarding the excessive speed of vehicles on Marlin Drive East. Mr. Lupinacci requested a speed hump on Marlin Drive East to slow vehicles. Board members requested speed data be collected. Lt. Rayburg will place the speed sentry in the area of 111 Marlin Drive East. This information will be presented at the January 2020 meeting. No further action.

Agenda Item 11: Request for Parking Restrictions in the 400 Block of Kenmont Avenue, Oak Way and Florence Place.

No one was in attendance to address this issue. No further action.

Agenda Item 12: Items from the Floor.

Mr. Carmine Bellini, 400 Edward Avenue requested a re-evaluation of the width of Kenmont Avenue to allow for parking on both sides of the roadway. This request will be placed on the January 2020 agenda.
