

## MT. LEBANON TRAFFIC BOARD

Meeting Date: January 8, 2020

Members Present: Mr. Glock, Mr. Sloan, Mr. Waine, Ms. Krieger, and Mr. Whitehead

Staff Present: Lt. Rayburg, Ms. Kostelich, Mr. Haberman

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Mr. Waine opened the meeting.

Agenda Item 1: Roll Call, Ms. Green was absent.

Agenda Item 2: Opening Remarks from Chair

Agenda Item 3: Meeting Notes from December 4, 2019.

Motion was made to approve the minutes from the December 4, 2019 meeting. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

### **Old Business:**

Agenda Item 4: Request to Evaluate Signal Timings and Lane Configuration at the Intersection of Cedar Boulevard and Morgan Drive / Greenhurst Drive.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers reviewed the recommendations that were presented at the November meeting. Mr. Haberman stated that this project would require the expenditure of capital funds with Commissioners approval. A motion was made to approve the recommendations for improvements to the traffic signal on Cedar Blvd at Morgan Drive / Greenhurst Drive. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 5: Request for Pedestrian Safety Improvements on Robb Hollow at the Intersection with Sylvandell and Driftwood.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers presented recommended improvements to the crosswalks and signage upgrades at the intersection of Sylvandell and Driftwood Drive. Motion was made to approve the recommendations presented by Mr. Haberman. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously. Letters will be sent to residents in the adjacent area advising them of the recommendations and to attend the February meeting to voice their concerns.

Agenda Item 6: Request for Stop Sign and No Left Turn on N. Meadowcroft Avenue at Edward Avenue.

Mr. Haberman stated that a field visit was conducted at this intersection and observations showed that due to the parking restrictions on N. Meadowcroft, near the intersection, the sight distance is adequate for drivers approaching Edward Avenue. No changes were recommended and no further action was taken.

Agenda Item 7: Review Scope and Proposal for Arden Road Traffic Calming Study.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers stated that a meeting was held with the residents of Arden Road on December 19, 2019 to present the scope of the study to be conducted. Mr. Haberman stated that the scope was expanded based on input from residents. Mr. Haberman stated the study will include data collection from 22 locations in the area. A motion was made to approve the scope of work and estimated fee for the alternative analysis. Motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

**New Business:**

Agenda Item 8: Request for Traffic Calming on Crystal Drive between Broadmoor and Country Club.

Mr. Jeffrey McNeil, 629 Crystal Drive presented a petition requesting a traffic calming study. Mr. McNeil spoke regarding the speed of vehicles near the intersection with Broadmoor and the number of children walking to school where there are no sidewalks.

Ms. Courtney Ivanov spoke regarding the speed of vehicles in the area of Crystal Drive and Broadmoor and also the number of children in the area that play outside and have to walk to school. Ms. Ivanov also spoke regarding the lack of sidewalks and Children Playing signs. Ms. Ivanov requested some type of traffic calming measure.

Mr. Haberman, Gateway Engineers stated that a preliminary study was conducted by Mt. Lebanon Police and the data that was collected did not meet the threshold for a traffic calming study.

Mr. Sloan suggested neighbors talk with their Commissioner regarding the installation of sidewalks. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 9: Request to Review Width Measurements of Kenmont Avenue.

No one was present to speak on this matter. No further action was taken.

Agenda Item 10: Items from the Floor.

Residents of Serpentine Drive requested Private Property signage at the entrance to the alleyway behind their residences, that is a private road and recently paved by the residents. This item will be place on the February agenda.

A resident of Lebanon Avenue requested audible signals be installed on the traffic signal on Cedar Blvd. at Cochran Road. This item will be place on the February agenda.

No additional items. Meeting adjourned at 7:50pm.
