Option 1: Join the Tour

On Saturday July 28, the Farmers Market will be happening in the Municipal Building area so meet us inside the lobby of the Municipal Building at 9am. Bring your walking shoes and dress for the weather. Come armed with your camera, tablet, phone or other device for capturing images. Don't forget your cords or memory devices so that we can transfer your images and print them for your story when we return from our walk.

This photo safari will cover the central part of Mt. Lebanon but you are welcome to take your own safari and head off to other parts of the community to take pictures and meet us back at the Municipal Building to share your story at 10:30am.

Option 2: On Your Own

Meet us in the Municipal Building at 9am with images you have already collected. If you have been taking pictures in Mt. Lebanon already or want to go out and gather images ahead of time, please bring your files on a USB, CD, SD card or other device so that we can print them and you can use them to create your personal story about Mt. Lebanon.

If you have a photo album, printed pictures or other historical images of Mt. Lebanon that you would like to share, please bring them. We can copy them on the spot and you can use them to create your story of what you see as important for Mt. Lebanon's future. You will have an opportunity to share your images and story with your neighbors.

Ready, set, share!

Whether you take pictures with the group or come with your own photos, after printing images, you will create an illustrated story ("storyboard") to share with the group and the planning team working on Mt. Lebanon's comprehensive plan. The images will help you make your point and share your story. It will then be used by the planning team to help shape Mt. Lebanon's comprehensive plan and create a guide for your community's successful future.

Rain?

We hope the weather cooperates but in the event that it rains, we will still be doing Option 2 (Option 1 will not occur). We will meet to create storyboards with those who have already compiled their images. There are two more photo safari tours coming up so you will still have an opportunity to participate if you want to walk with us.
