

Mt. Lebanon Golf Course Opens May 1!

Beginning on Friday May 1, golf is permitted to reopen in Pennsylvania, but under strict guidelines to protect the health and safety of our patrons and staff, and to help stop the spread of COVID-19. **It will not be golf as usual. Please pay careful attention to the new rules of golf.**

Tee times are now required. Every day from open until close, reservations are required for tee times. You may make a tee time up to one week in advance by calling the golf shop at 412-561-9761. **Do not arrive more than 15 minutes prior to your tee time.**

Credit cards are required. We can take your credit card at the time of reservation, or if necessary, we can accept your credit card payment at the clubhouse. Only one person at a time is permitted inside the clubhouse.

Masks. You must wear a mask in and around the clubhouse.

Arrival instructions. When you arrive at the golf course with your pre-reserved tee time, if you have already paid, report to the golf course starter stationed in front of the clubhouse. If you need to pay, report to the clubhouse upper level. Once you have paid, our staff will direct you to the first tee.

Carts. Beginning 5/29, we are allowing household members to ride in a riding cart together. All other cart riders are remaining one rider per cart and only one set of clubs are permitted on each riding cart. All riding carts will be sanitized by golf course employees after every round. It is the golfer's responsibility to remove all trash from the cart upon the completion of their round. Only a limited number of carts (34) are available. **If you are able, please walk the golf course.**

Practice physical distancing. Physical distancing among patrons and employees will be enforced at all times. This applies to all areas of the golf course property including but not limited to the front of the clubhouse, both parking lots and the deck. When your round is over, go home.

No large groups. All leagues, outings and camps will be curtailed until distancing requirements are lifted and we believe it is safe return to group golf activities.

The short game area is closed. To deter large gatherings, the short game green (near #2 green) will be closed (except for contracted instructors) until further notice. The putting green near the clubhouse will be open as long as physical distancing is observed. A 5-minute time limit will be enforced on the putting green in order to give other golfers an opportunity to warm up.

Do not touch flagsticks. The flagsticks on each putting green must remain in the cup at all times. The cups will be inverted in order prevent the ball from falling to the bottom of the hole making for easy retrieval.

Bunkers and ball washers. All ball washers and bunker rakes have been removed from the golf course. If you find yourself in a bunker, place the ball and play on. Please smooth the bunker with your foot or golf club.

Restroom Facilities. The single bathroom on the lower clubhouse level will be available for emergencies. The bathroom will be regularly sanitized by golf course employees. The locker rooms are closed. Customers and employees must wear masks anywhere in the clubhouse.

Visitors to the golf course are not permitted. To help prevent crowding, all non-essential visitors to the golf course are prohibited.

Bring a water bottle. Vending machines are closed.

In general, protect yourself and others. Don't come to the golf course if you feel sick. Bring hand sanitizer in your golf bag, and use it often. No high fives or handshakes. Practice good hygiene by covering coughs or sneezes with a sleeve or elbow. Stay 6 feet apart at all times, and wear a mask in and around the clubhouse.
