Ninth annual Public Safety Camp! Public safety camp is a group effort by the Mt. Lebanon Fire, Police Departments and Medical Rescue Team South EMS. The camp is for children ages 9 to 12. We will begin each morning with a flag ceremony, and roll call. Each day will have different events related to all three public safety departments. Throughout the week campers will have the opportunity to: see and touch the different vehicles used by public safety, participate in a bike rodeo, use a hose line from a fire engine, learn CPR and First Aid, play in 3 feet deep foam, participate in a rope rescue scenario, wear firefighter turnout gear, crawl through a maze, and see a vehicle rescue demonstration. Friday will end with a graduation ceremony.
