SUPPLIES NEEDED: All youth must bring the following supplies: One lifelike baby doll, mask and a bottle of water with participants last name.

This class is excellent for youth who want to learn how to be responsible and understand the important basic tools and concepts needed to keep a child safe and happy as a **Babysitter** or a **"Family Youth Helper"**. This is a wonderful class for a girl or boy who has become an older brother or sister to a new baby, gaining confidence and awareness while responsibly caring for any younger family members. *Want to learn how to be a "Parent Helper"?* This class will include tips for the student to support a parent or an adult and assist and care for a little one while an adult is home and be a "family" youth helper too.

Step-by-step procedures to help get those Babysitting jobs and introduce the student as an effective babysitter from start to end is covered so the experience can be more responsible and positive! Simple First-aid and essential safety practices, basics regarding playtime, activities, feeding and simple age-appropriate behavior and development ideas will be covered.

Students can ask questions, examples of real-life scenarios will be discussed, and the student will gain confidence in having the basic tools needed to babysit, assist and care for a younger child by the end of the class.

Material and handouts will be provided along with a Certificate of Participation.
