- **Approval of June, 2019 Minutes.** Natalie motioned to approve the June 2019 minutes. Heather seconded and all members in attendance approved.

- **ESB Business**

- Laura Lilley – Public Information Office. Laura advised the Board regarding the status of the Waste Management recycling contract. She stated that WM was supposed to be tagging recycling containers; however, they had only recently started doing this. The intent was to advise residents what they were doing incorrectly, but up to this point, it was not being done. Laura explained that SHACOG and WM had defined terms for fines and contamination, and said that clam shells in the recycling wouldn't be fined. She continued to explain the Communication Plan that had just been approved by the Commission. Implementation of the plan had been delayed until WM defined what and how fines would be assessed. A series of communication vehicles would include a direct mail postcard, stickers that would be delivered via the magazine, information in the New Resident packets, and posters. She discussed with the ESB that their expertise would be valuable, and that perhaps the Board could provide a recycling tip for each of ten magazine issues. The Board discussed how this would be accomplished, and decided to begin a list on a Google Doc so that everyone could contribute. Laura also provided a demo of an app that could assist residents regarding what should and should not be recycled, would push out changes to pick-up schedules, and provide a communication avenue with residents, among other things.
