- **Public Comment.** Charlotte Stephenson commented regarding the lateral testing ordinance.
- **Approval of March, 2019 Minutes.** Bethany motioned to approve the March 2019 minutes. Heather seconded and all members in attendance approved.
- **ESB Business**
 - Heather Wechter was introduced as a new board member.
 - Election of Chair and Co-Chair
 - Abby Lawler Morycz was nominated as Chair Person of the ESB. Nora motioned to approve; Heather seconded and all members in attendance approved.
 - Nora was nominated as Co-Chair Person of the ESB. Heather motioned to approve; Natalie seconded and all members in attendance approved.
 - Earth Day Update – Abby updated the Board regarding the Earth Day Program.
- **Commission Business.**
 - Gateway Engineers – Mike Albright and Ashley Neptune of Gateway Engineers provided the Board with an update on the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) requirements. Mike explained that there are six Minimum Control Measures (MCM) that Mt. Lebanon is required to fulfill, and that MCM 1, Public Education, and MCM 2, Public Involvement are two of the measures with which the ESB could assist. Ways in which the Board could assist would be to promote or host various recycling and hazardous waste collections and workshops, distribute educational material, and organize stream and roadside cleanups.
 - Recycling Plan – Board members discussed ways in which the ESB could promote how to recycle correctly. Items discussed included providing tutorials and displays at public events.
 - June 8 – Glass recycling would be located in the Commissioners lot in Mt. Lebanon. It was noted that the PRC needed volunteers for the event.
