REGISTRATION

Main ice session size is limited to 10 skaters of mixed skating levels. Open enrollment is available throughout the program, provided space is available.

ELIGIBILITY RULES

All figure skaters must be receiving private lessons from a qualified professional with an approved contract. POD/Small Group Training is acceptable on low attendance sessions where enrollment is five skaters or less. Skater must have passed U.S.F.S. Basic # 3 or equivalent skills.

Skaters below Basic #3 may only be on the ice while on lesson with a Mt. Lebanon Recreation Center Staff Professional.

TEST SESSIONS

USFS Test Sessions may be offered by the Skating Club of Mt. Lebanon TBD. Test sessions are not a part of the school. All skaters wishing to take USFS tests must present letters of permission from their local test chairperson no later than seven days prior to scheduled test. Test fees are not included in school fees.

POLICIES

1. Mt. Lebanon Recreation Center reserves the right to limit attendance on all sessions and amend any of the policies and/or schedules set forth in this document.
2. All skaters must register online and be pre-registered. Space is limited per 30-minute session. Session will be filled on a first come first serve basis. Sessions for Free Skating/Moves in the Field/Dance have been assigned by the rink. If overcrowding becomes an issue, first priority will be given to Mt. Lebanon residents and the students of Mt. Lebanon Recreation Center Staff Professionals.
3. Refunds. There will be no refunds given.
4. All skaters must meet Eligibility Skill Requirements (see page one) and sign the daily attendance sheet BEFORE going on the ice.
5. Figure Skating Eligibility Skills (see page one) and proper skating etiquette is required on all sessions. Hockey skates and hockey skills /drills are permitted only during their designated time.
6. Parents/guardians and skaters may watch the session from the bleachers. Mask guidelines must be followed. Disruptive behavior will result in this privilege being revoked.
7. **June 28, 2021: Indoors, masks are only required for unvaccinated individuals. Masks are not required for anyone outdoors. Social distancing and frequent handwashing are encouraged. In general, protect yourself and others. Don't attend programs if you feel sick or are otherwise at risk. These guidelines are subject to change.**
